The Prison Letters group seeks to:

- 1) Enhance prisoners' access and awareness of resources;
- 2) Support prisoners in their transition to outside life;
- 3) Raise awareness of the struggles and challenges of people in and out of prison; and
- 4) Demystify some of the associated stigma and myths.

Prison systems are not only designed to keep people in, but also to keep the community out. Without access or contact, prisoners are isolated from the supports and information needed to increase their quality of life and reduce potential for conflicts to arise. Academics and students have significant access to information and resources. The Prison Letters group seeks to utilize and share these resources for those who have little or no access at all.
